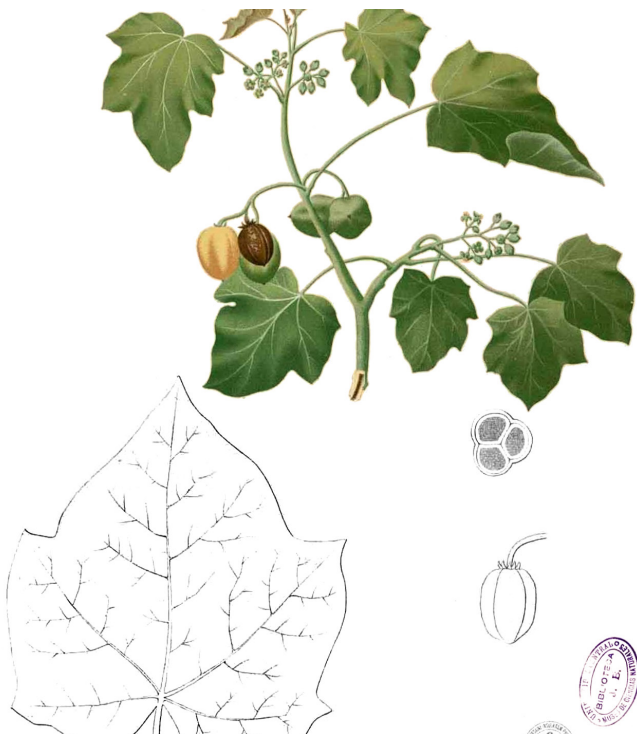

Description: Deciduous small tree or shrub to 5m tall with watery latex. Leaves variable, pale green, 3-5 lobed, papery. Inflorescences in leaf axils, male and female flowers on same plant, flowers small, white to pale yellow. Fruit an ellipsoid capsule yellow with black seeds.

Habitat: Disturbed upland sites
