

Florida Forever Conservation Data Viewer

This interactive map displays statewide natural resource layers that correspond to the legislative goals and measures for the Florida Forever land acquisition program, and are collectively part of an analysis known as the Florida Forever Conservation Needs Assessment (FFCNA). The map allows users to display any of 10 prioritized natural resource layers overlaid with Florida Forever project boundaries.

Conservation Boundary Layers

Florida Forever BOT Projects: This group contains the boundaries of all current Florida Forever environmental land acquisition projects administered by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Division of State Lands, for the State Board of Trustees (BOT).

Unacquired Portions: This layer contains only the portions of projects remaining to be acquired and represents the lands evaluated and ranked by the Acquisition and Restoration Council.

Full Project Boundaries: This layer contains boundaries for the entire project, including areas that have already been acquired.

Rural and Family Lands Protection Program Projects: This layer contains boundaries for projects proposed for less-than-fee acquisition through the Rural and Family Lands Protection Program (RFLPP).

Florida Conservation Lands: This layer includes boundaries and statistics for more than 2,500 federal, state, local, and private managed areas. National parks, state forests, wildlife management areas, local and private preserves are examples of the managed areas included.
